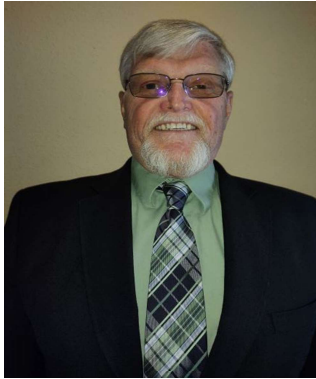


Daniel Stouffer
